(The 20th year of this Belnap Family tradition, begun Christmas 1991)
6. Children: Open one present
(Belnap Family tradition since early 1960s; gift: new pajamas)
7. Christmas Program:
David – "Blue Christmas" on guitar
Caroline – "You Are Special" and Testimony
Christopher – Testimony
Spencer – "Interesting Christmas Facts"
Rebecca and Nathan – "Jingle Bells"
8. Re-enactment of the Nativity Story:
David – Wiseman
Caroline – Angel
Christopher – Shepherd/Innkeeper
Spencer – Joseph
Rebecca – Mary
Nathan – Baby Jesus
9. Place Baby Jesus in Jerusalem olive wood manger
(The 15th year of this Belnap Family tradition, begun Christmas 1996;
assigned to the youngest capable child; Nativity Set purchased in 1984)
Sing "Away In A Manger" (Hymn #206)
10. Light "Shepherds' Field" candle;
Pass light to family members
(The 27th year of this Belnap Family tradition, begun Christmas 1984;
begun at "Mormon Shepherds' Field" near Bethlehem on April 5, 1984;
candle should be lit on Christmas Eve at 11:00 p.m. Utah time where feasible;)
11. Sing "Silent Night" (Hymn #204) and "I Wonder When
He Comes Again" (Children's Songbook p. 82)
12. Listen to Christmas carols around Christmas Tree;
Watch "Polar Express";
Tuck children into bed and say prayers
