1. **Kadesh** (קדש) (Sanctify)

Fill and drink first cup

2. **Urchatz** (ורחץ) (Wash)

3. **Karpas** (כרפס) (Parsley)

4. **Yachatz** (יחץ) (Divide)

5. **Maggid** (מגיד) (Tell)

Fill second cup

*Blood
Frogs
Vermin
A mixture of noxious beasts
Pestilence
Boils
Hail
Locusts
Darkness
Slaying of the first-born*

"Dayenu"

Drink second cup

6. **Rachtzah** (רחצה) (Wash)

7. **Motzi** (מוציא) (Blessing)

8. **Matzah** (מצה) (Unleavened Bread)

9. **Maror** (מרור) (Bitter Herbs)

10. **Korekh** (כורך) (Sandwich)

11. **Shulchan Arukh** (שולחן ערוך) (Prepared Table)

Eat meal (start with Beitzah)

12. **Tzafun** (צפון) (Ransomed)

13. **Barekh** (ברך) (Blessing)

Fill and drink third cup

Welcome the Prophet Elijah

14. **Hallel** (הלל) (Praise)

Fill and drink fourth cup

15. **Nirtzah** (נירצה) (Acceptance)
